*When You Need Something*

- If you know of a congregant who would like a home or hospital visit, call Carole in the office. Cynthia Flax and Roberta Gottesman have generously started a sunshine outreach to our friends in the synagogue.

*Memorial Candles & Birthday Greetings*

- The Congregation sends out a reminder letter with a memorial candle when you have a yahrzeit for a loved one. We also send annual birthday greetings. Let the office know if you would prefer to not receive candles, or are not receiving reminder letters/ birthday greetings.

*Remembrance/Dedications*

- If you would like to honor your loved ones who have departed, we offer Memorial Plaques in the Sanctuary. They are a permanent remembrance for those who are no longer with us. The cost is \$500 per plaque. In addition, one can dedicate a Prayer book to honor a special occasion (\$36) or a gold leaf for the vestibule's Tree of Life (\$200). For more information, please call Carole in the office.
- As our Mi Sheberach list grows, we are not sure if some of our congregants and friends still need to be on the list. Please call Carole so that we can update our list and keep it current.

*Cemetery*

- The Cemetery Rules and Fees document of Congregation Shaara Tfillle spells out eligibility, rights, and fees. It also sets guidelines for use of the building and sanctuary during funerals. Call the office at 518-584-2370 if you wish to receive an electronic copy of the document.
- Our Cemetery is open year round. We ask that you be careful when visiting. The walkway can be slippery.

*Services*

### **Using Required Minimum Distributions (RMD) for Synagogue Contributions**

For the people who have IRAs (Individual Retirement Accounts), it is required to withdraw money every year starting the year that one turns 73. These withdrawals are called Required Minimum Distributions, or RMDs. Your Financial Advisor typically calculates the amount that must be withdrawn based on the balances in your account on January 1 of each year. The money taken out of an IRA is taxable. If, however, one contributes all or part of the money taken out of an IRA to an eligible charity, that money is NOT taxed.

Therefore it is highly advantageous to contribute IRA withdrawals directly to the charity of your choice. To that end, please consider paying dues and making other contributions to the Synagogue directly from your IRAs. Food for thought.

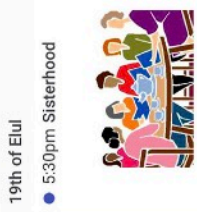
